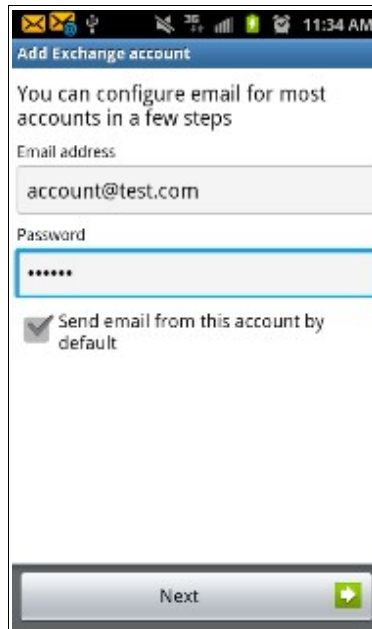


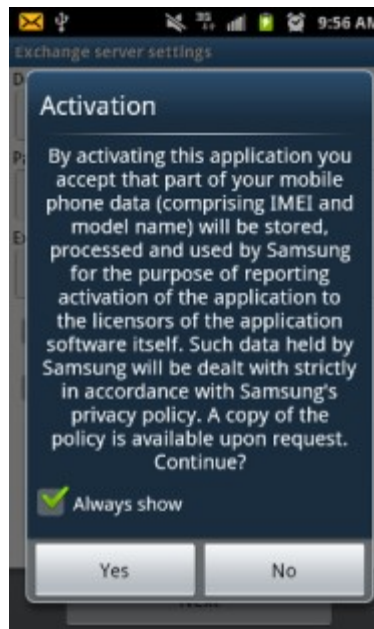
On your phone go to Applications, Settings, Accounts and sync, and click “Add account”.

Click “Corporate” or “Microsoft Exchange ActiveSync”
(depends on the firmware version of your phone)

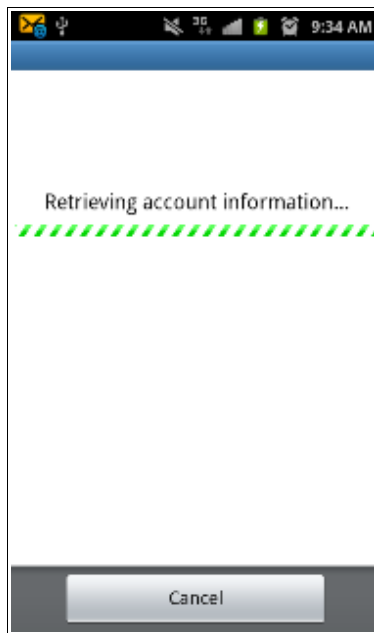
Fill in your email address and password and click “Next”.



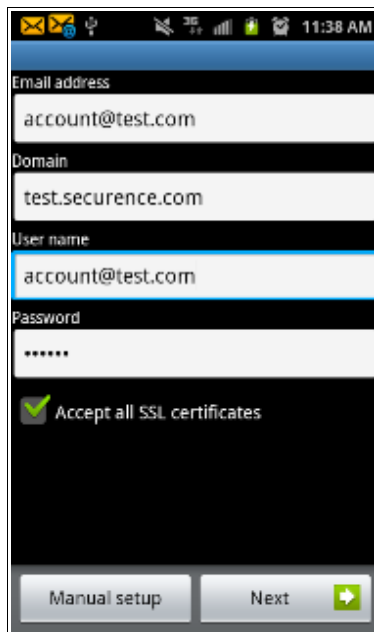
If you get something similar to the below screen shot, click “yes”.



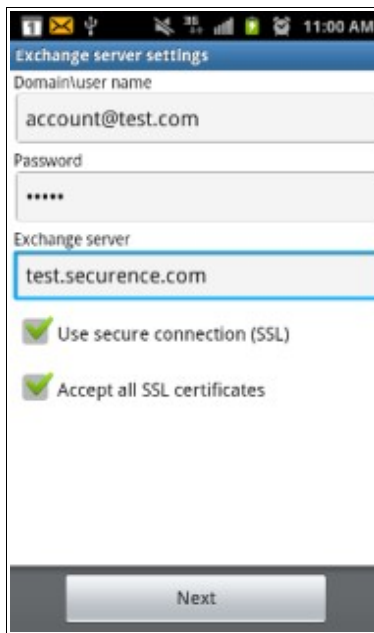
Your phone will now check the settings you entered against the settings on the server.



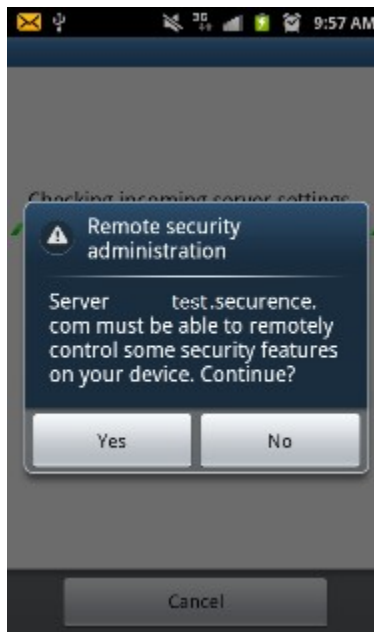
Leave the settings that are there and click “Manual setup”.



Enter your username, password, Exchange server. (same as OWA address or *domain.securence.com*), and check both boxes.



Once that has completed successfully you will get a remote security administration screen, click “yes” to continue.



The next screen will show your account options, you can set them to what works for you or leave them as default, scroll down to see all the options, and click “Next” when finished.



The last step is to create a name for the account, this can be anything you like. Click “Done” to complete the setup.
